

# **TURKISH STEEL INDUSTRY**

Today Türkiye has 26 electric arc furnace mill plants (EAF), 11 induction furnice plants and 3 BOF plants.


In 2022, global output decrease to 1.88 billion tons, down by 4.2% on 2021. Türkiye's output was 40.4 million tons with an increase of 12.7% in 2021. In 2022, Türkiye's output was around 35.1 million tons with a decrease of 12.9% on 2021.

In 1996, The European Coal and Steel Community (ECSC) agreement was signed between the EU and Türkiye. With signing the agreement, customs duties on bilateral steel trade were abolished. The agreement allows

Türkiye to trade its iron and steel products without customs duty with all EU member states. Additionally, the Government does not subsidize Turkish domestic steel industry due to the European Coal and Steel Community (ECSC) agreement.

All steel companies in the country are privately held, and Turkish steelmakers continue to pursue technological developments to enhance the long-term viability of the industry in the global marketplace. The steel industry has become one of the most developed sectors in Türkiye and today counts as the fourth largest contributor to the Turkish economy.

# TÜRKİYE'S STEEL MAP




# A GROWING INDUSTRY

After 1980, with the implementation of import substitution system, Türkiye has increased her steel export to primarily neighboring countries such as Iran, Iraq and North African countries.

In the next 20 years, Türkiye realized a major production and export boom. While Türkiye was the world's 10<sup>th</sup> biggest steel producer in 2001, she has become the 7<sup>th</sup> biggest producer globally and largest steel producer in Europe in 2020. In fact, she was the third fastest growing steel producer in the world between 2020 and 2021.

In 2022, due to shrinking global steel demand, Türkiye's steel production decreased and declined to 8<sup>th</sup> biggest producer globally and second largest steel producer in Europe. On the other hand, in 2022 Türkiye has become 5<sup>th</sup> biggest steel exporter globally thanks to her high quality and competitive steel products.







# TURKISH STEEL IN THE WORLD

Turkish steel manufacturers export to all over the world, due to competitive prices and effective marketing strategies. According to 2022 figures, Türkiye's main export region was the European Union with 5.7 million tons, making 29% of Türkiye's total steel exports. Middle East was another main export destination of Turkish steel exports with 4.2 million tons with a decrease of 2% in 2022. The most significant increase was recorded in the Other European Countries by 21%, while the region was the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest export market for Turkish steel exporters in 2022 with 2.4 million tons. In addition, Türkiye's steel export to North Africa recovered and reached the level of 2 million tons. On the other hand, export to Latin America decreased by 44% to 1.7 million tons in 2022.
