

Important Notice for Tube 2026!

To support you in your preparations, we would like to remind you of some essential topics regarding your booth construction, booth staffing, and opening hours.

Visitor Opening Hours

Please note the opening hours for Tube 2026:

- April 13–16: 09:30 AM – 06:00 PM
- April 17: 09:30 AM – 04:00 PM

Occupation of your exhibition stand on the last Day

Please ensure that your booth is adequately occupied with information personnel during the exhibition hours and remains accessible to visitors at all times. To provide an optimal experience for all participants, we reserve the right to relocate booths for Tube 2028 if they are not staffed, particularly on the final day, or if dismantling begins before the end of the fair. This measure is monitored and documented by Messe Düsseldorf. Thank you for your understanding.

Please verify that the following criteria regarding your booth construction are met and communicate these to your booth builder:

Wall Covering

Booths may be constructed with your own materials. For the rear walls of booths taller than 2.50 meters, the design should be neutral and clean, using colors such as white, gray, or beige, consistent with the booth's overall appearance, so as not to interfere with neighboring booths' interests.

Aisle Clearance

For safety reasons, escape and rescue routes must not be obstructed by booth materials or other installations. Regardless of hall aisle width, a minimum clearance of 1.20 meters must be maintained in the aisles. Along the booth boundaries facing the hall aisle, a maximum strip of 0.90 meters wide may be used for placing booth materials, especially during setup and dismantling.

Presentations/Music on the Booth

Presentations, visual, slowly moving advertising displays, as well as audio or audiovisual content, are permitted provided they do not disturb neighbors, cause congestion in the aisles, or drown out the hall's public address system. The volume must not exceed 70 dB(A) at the booth boundary.

Cable Management

For the installation of heavier-duty pipes or cables, prior approval and price agreement with Messe Düsseldorf are required. All such work must be carried out exclusively according to Messe Düsseldorf's specifications and by approved specialized companies. The costs are borne by the exhibitor.

Advertising Towards Neighboring Booths

Advertising outside your own booth area on Messe Düsseldorf premises may only be conducted by Messe Düsseldorf's service partners. Any directed advertising towards neighboring booths must maintain a minimum distance of 3.00 meters. The enclosed portion of a hall side wall built into the aisle should not exceed approximately 30%, to preserve the open character of the exhibition stand. In other words, at least 70% of the open side must remain unobstructed.

Decorative Materials and Artificial Plants

Flammable or dripping materials, polystyrene foam (Styrofoam), or similar substances are prohibited. All decorative materials must meet DIN 4102, at least class B1 (fire-retardant). Equivalent certifications in German according to EN 13501 are accepted. Materials such as bamboo, reed, hay, straw, bark mulch, peat, or similar are not permitted. Artificial plants must not be arranged vertically (e.g., on walls) or overhead.

Machines / Safety / Protective Devices

Machines may only be exhibited if they bear the CE mark. Machine and device parts may only be operated with all safety devices in place. Standard safety devices can be replaced with a secure cover made of organic glass or a similar transparent material. When devices are not in operation, the safety covers may be removed to allow visitors to see the construction and design of the covered parts. The safety devices must then remain visibly positioned next to the machine.
